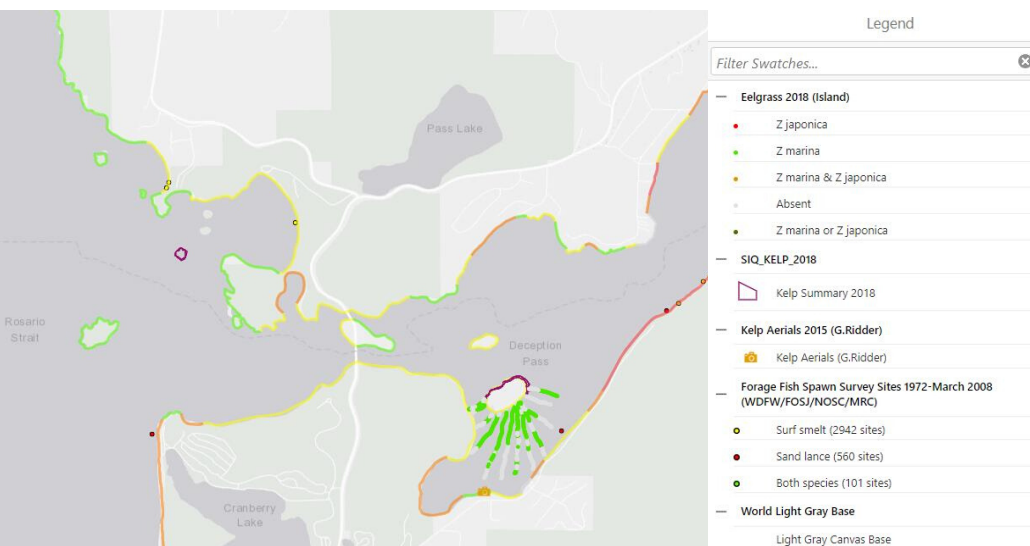


What is SoundIQ?

SoundIQ is the Northwest Straits Commission's web-based application to share data collected throughout the Northwest Straits Initiative including the seven Marine Resources Committees (MRCs). SoundIQ showcases a vast amount of data in an easily-accessible map format. Northwest Straits data on SoundIQ can be viewed in combination with complementary data from other sources and partners.

Who can use SoundIQ?

Anyone can access and use it! Some common users include Northwest Straits Initiative members, project partners, county planners, students and curious members of the public.



What can I do with SoundIQ?

- Access data from all over the Northwest Straits Initiative
- Learn about projects
- Find MRC data and reports
- Search and download data (marine plant and animal species, shoreline restoration, etc.)
- View and change visible map data layers
- Print or share a map
