


Benefits of Natural Space for Agriculture

health, improve climate resilience, and compliment the


adjacent conservation and restoration work.




Community Partners: It Takes a Village




















OFS & Regenerative Agriculture

- Use of diverse crops, cover crops and tarps to keep soil covered
- Keeping living roots in the soil whenever possible
- Incorporation of livestock with crop production
- Reduction of tillage -Perpetually diversifying plants in the field
- Care for the soil biome
