

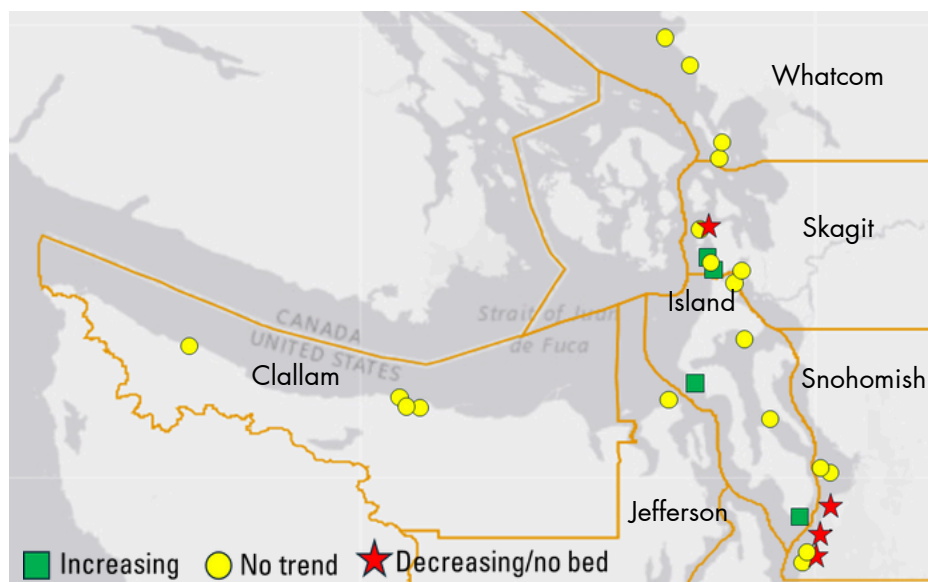

WHAT IS THE MRC FLOATING KELP MONITORING PROJECT?

The Marine Resources Committees' (MRCs) Floating Kelp Monitoring Project is a community science-based project that measures "floating" kelp (i.e., bull kelp and giant kelp that grow to the surface of the water) bed area 1-4 times during summer months via kayaks at select sites each year.

Launched in 2015, this project is coordinated by the Northwest Straits Commission and is led by the Clallam, Jefferson, Island, Snohomish, Skagit, and Whatcom MRCs. The goal of this project is to better understand local kelp forests.

PURPOSE

MONITORING TRENDS IN FLOATING KELP FORESTS IN THE NORTHWEST STRAITS REGION

This project monitors floating kelp beds at select sites across the Northwest Straits Region to better understand kelp bed trends and to help MRCs inform their governments and communities about local kelp forests.

Collected data is also provided to partners to use in various research projects and resource tools, including WA Department of Natural Resources' [Floating Kelp Indicator](#) and [Floating Kelp Linear Extent Data Viewer](#).

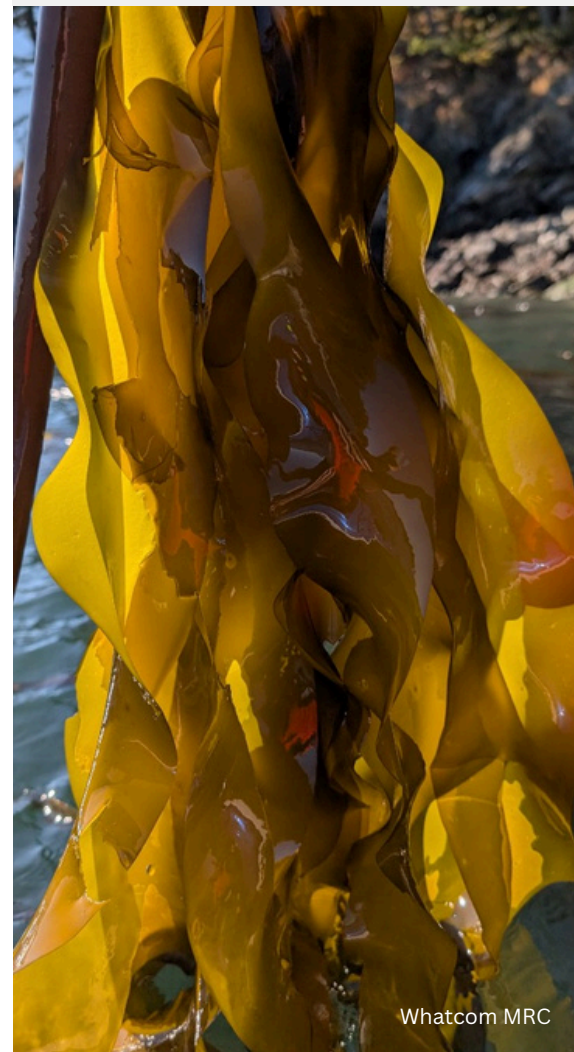
